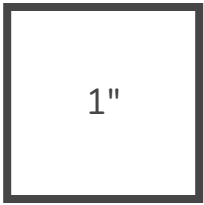


This pattern is to scale. Printer setting should be "Actual size" / 100%.



If your printer allows, choose "Borderless printing" so the pattern's lines print right to the edge of the paper. If your printer doesn't have that option, you'll have a white space along the edge of your paper, but cut your pattern piece as though the cut-line goes right to the edge.

KITCHENAID MIXER BOWL COVER

- Cut 1 piece from fabric
- Cut 1 piece from food-safe plastic
- Cut a 5" x 1-3/4" peice of fabric for the tab
- Cut 1/2" (13mm) wide elastic to 24" long
- Cut 1 piece of velcro 1-1/2" long
- 1/2" seam allowance
- Cut one line perpendicular to the circle's edge that is 2" long for the slit
