


This pattern is to scale. Printer setting should be "Actual size" / 100%.



If your printer allows, choose "Boarderless printing" so the pattern's lines print right to the edge of the paper. If your printer doesn't have that option, you'll have a white space along the edge of your paper, but cut your pattern piece as though the cut-line goes right to the edge.

LARGE BOWL COVER (BEGINNER)

Fits bowls approx 10" - 12" in diameter

- Cut 2 pieces from fabric for top & bottom (to make this cover waterproof, use food-safe PUL for bottom instead)
- Cut 1/4" wide elastic to 18" long
 - 1/2" seam allowance

SMALL BOWL COVER (BEGINNER)

Fits bowls approx 4" - 6" in diameter

- Cut 2 pieces from fabric for top & bottom (to make this cover waterproof, use food-safe PUL for bottom instead)
- Cut 1/4" wide elastic to 12" long
- 1/2" seam allowance

MEDIUM BOWL COVER (BEGINNER)

Fits bowls approx 7" - 9" in diameter

- Cut 2 pieces from fabric for top & bottom (to make this cover waterproof, use food-safe PUL for bottom instead)
- Cut 1/4" wide elastic to 15" long
- 1/2" seam allowance

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
