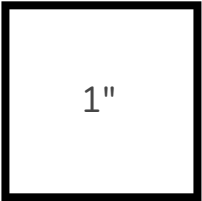


If your printer allows, choose "Borderless printing" so the pattern's lines print right to the edge of the paper.
If your printer doesn't have that option, you'll have a white space along the edge of your paper, but cut your pattern piece as though the cut-line goes right to the edge.

This pattern is to scale. Printer setting should be "Actual size" / 100%.



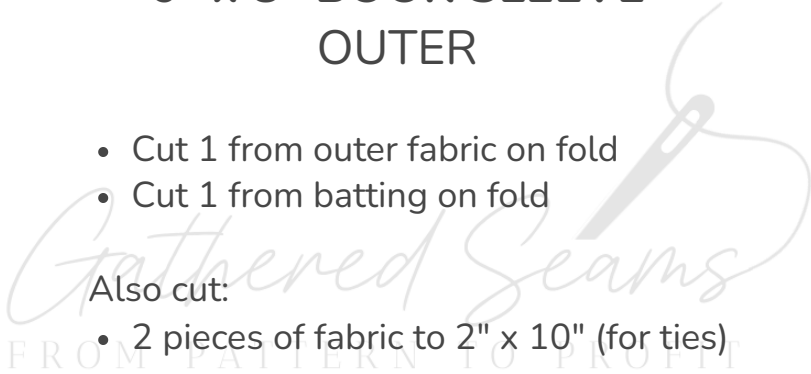
*Check scale

**6" x 8" BOOK SLEEVE
OUTER**

- Cut 1 from outer fabric on fold
- Cut 1 from batting on fold

Also cut:

- 2 pieces of fabric to 2" x 10" (for ties)

CUT ON FOLD

6" x 8" BOOK SLEEVE LINING/POCKETS

- Use full pattern piece to cut 2 from lining fabric

For the zipper pocket, also cut:

- 2 pieces of fabric to **1-1/2" x 9"** (for zipper pocket right side)
- 2 pieces of fabric to **1-1/4" x 1-5/8"** (for zipper tabs)
- #5 zipper to 8" long

FOLD PATTERN PIECE ALONG THIS LINE, THEN CUT 4
(FOR TOP & LINING OF BOOK POCKETS)

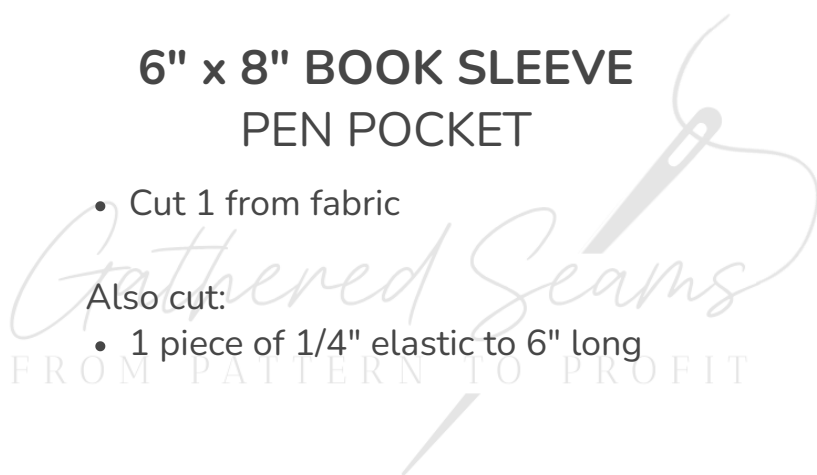
FOLD PATTERN PIECE ALONG THIS LINE, THEN CUT 2
(FOR TOP & LINING OF ZIPPER POCKET LEFT SIDE)

6" x 8" BOOK SLEEVE PEN POCKET

- Cut 1 from fabric

Also cut:

- 1 piece of 1/4" elastic to 6" long
